ABOUT EDWARD M. ARMFIELD, SR.

Edward M. Armfield knew that a good education is essential to a successful career – and to a successful life. Born in 1915 in Asheboro, North Carolina, Mr. Armfield spent most of his adult life in Greensboro. He was educated at The McCallie School in Chattanooga, Tennessee and at Davidson College, graduating in 1937. While at Davidson, he was an outstanding athlete and was active in a number of campus organizations. In 1992, he was inducted into Davidson's Athletic Hall of Fame.

After graduation, Mr. Armfield began his career in the textile industry. At age 30, he founded his own textile company, which he successfully operated until his retirement in 1986. Mr. Armfield also owned TWP, Inc., an electronics company headquartered in Cranford, NJ, and also TWP, Inc. International with facilities in Mexico, Spain, England, Sweden and China. He remained active in TWP, Inc. until his death in July 1999.

During his lifetime, Edward Armfield provided financial assistance to a number of students, so they could further their education. Because of his concern for those who find it financially challenging to get an education, he established The Edward M. Armfield, Sr. Foundation, Inc.

INTRODUCTION

Since its inception in 1999, The Edward M. Armfield, Sr. Foundation has awarded college scholarships to selected students graduating from public high schools in Surry County. Each year, scholarships are awarded at each of the five traditional Surry County high schools, Surry Early College High School and Millennium Charter Academy to students who will be attending four-year colleges and universities or Surry Community College. Scholarships are also available to students graduating with an associate degree from Surry Community College and continuing toward their bachelor's degree. Scholarship awards vary and are determined based on financial need and the cost of the school the student will be attending. Scholarships are renewable for one additional year for Surry Early College High School graduates, students transferring from Surry Community College to compete their bachelor's degree, and for students entering Surry Community College from high school. Scholarships are renewable for up to three additional years for students attending four-year colleges and universities immediately after high school. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required for all renewals. To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must demonstrate financial need by complete and uploading a FAFSA form. Once financial need is determined, a selection committee evaluates applicants based on academic performance, extracurricular activities, a letter of recommendation, and a personal statement. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for The Armfield Foundation scholarship, an applicant must be:

- A May 2024 graduate of a public high school in Surry County, North Carolina including Surry Early College High School, with plans to attend an accredited four-year college/university or Surry Community College in the fall of 2024 as a full-time student, or
- A May 2024 graduate of Millennium Charter Academy with plans to attend an accredited four-year college/university or Surry Community College in the fall of 2024 as a full-time student, or
- A May 2024 graduate of Surry Community College who previously graduated from a public high school in Surry County and who plans to enter an accredited four-year college/university in the fall of 2024 to complete their bachelor's degree as a full-time student.

Scholarships are available only to full-time undergraduate students and are awarded on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis.

SELECTION PROCESS

Each of the five Surry County traditional high schools, Surry Early College High School and Surry Community College has a screening committee made up of personnel from that school. Each screening committee reviews scholarship applications from their school and submits nominees to the Scholarship Selection Committee. The Scholarship Selection Committee makes the final determination as to which nominees are awarded scholarships. This determination is made based on the Scholarship Selection Committee's ranking of nominees, with scholarships offered to nominees in order of their ranking. Alternate scholarship recipients will also be named by the Selection Committee. The Armfield Foundation will notify scholarship recipients, alternates, and non-recipients by April 26, 2024.

HOW TO APPLY

To be considered for The Armfield Foundation scholarship, students must complete an online application by Friday, February 16, 2024, at noon, EST at <https://armfieldscholars.communityforce.com>. To be eligible for the scholarship, all sections of the online form must be completed, and all required documents must be uploaded by the deadline.

Completion of this application will require that you:

- Complete all sections of the online application;
- Submit a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), print or save an electronic copy of your SAR (student aid report), and upload it;
- Have an email address for your desired recommender(s), so that you can have the recommendation form emailed directly from our website to your recommender(s) for submission;
- Have an email address for your guidance counselor or advisor, so that you can have the academic transcript portion of the application emailed directly to your guidance counselor or advisor for submission;
- Review your application with a parent or guardian and both provide an electronic signature agreeing to the terms of The Armfield Foundation scholarship application process.

Applications not completed by Friday, February 16, 2024, at noon EST will not be eligible for The Armfield Foundation scholarship. **No exceptions will be made.**

DEADLINE

To be considered for The Armfield Foundation scholarship, students must complete an online application by Friday, February 16, 2024, at noon, EST. To be eligible for the scholarship, all sections of the online form must be completed at <https://armfieldscholars.communityforce.com>, and all required documents must be uploaded by the deadline.
